**Weekly Offering Envelopes** - The new Weekly Offering Envelopes are now available in the concourse, please don't use until April these are for the new financial year.

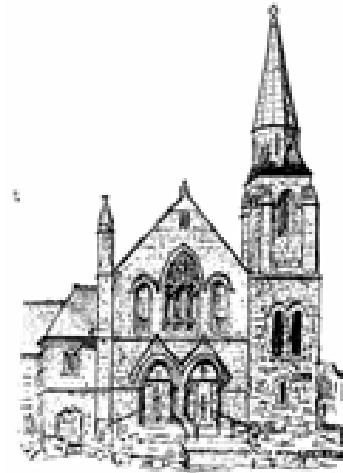
